

NAME

lfumount — unmount the logical file system (LFS)

SYNOPSIS

lfumount *char_dev*

DESCRIPTION

Lfumount unmounts a Logical File System (LFS); i.e., the block device containing the physical storage for the LFS is disassociated from the character device for the LFS in question (see *lfmount*(1)). The character special file *char_dev* is assumed to be in */dev*. The entry for */dev/char_dev* is also removed from the mount table in */etc/lmtab*.

<i>/etc/lmtab</i>	LFS mount table
<i>/dev/char_dev</i>	Character special file, one per LFS

DIAGNOSTICS

Diagnostics are given if UNIX returns errors on opening, reading, or writing */etc/lmtab*, or if *char_dev* is not present in the internal mount table kept by the LFS software. The use of *lfumount* is limited to the super user. A diagnostic is given otherwise.

WARNINGS

Since */etc/lmtab* is maintained separately from the internal mount table, they can become inconsistent. Thus, it is possible for *lfumount* to complain that *char_dev* is not in */etc/lmtab*, although it correctly removed it from the internal table.
